

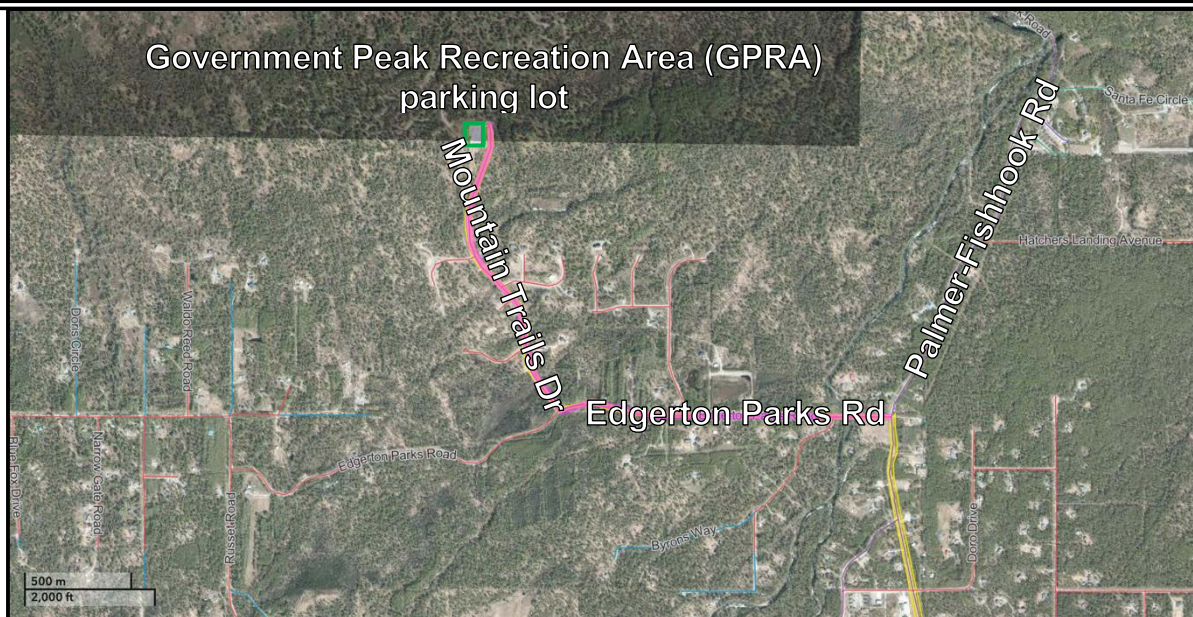


# PROJECT UPDATE

# Matanuska-Susitna Borough PROJECT FACTS



### Description

This project will provide a non-motorized pathway along the north side of Edgerton Parks Rd and west side of Mountain Trails Dr from Palmer-Fishhook Rd to the Government Peak Recreation Area (GPRA) parking lot. Improvements to Edgerton Parks Rd are also included in the project.

### Benefits

Provide a safe location, out of the vehicle traffic lanes, for people walking, running, and biking to travel between Palmer-Fishhook Rd and Government Peak Recreation Area, one of the most popular recreation sites in the borough.

### Cost

Estimated total cost: \$8,500,000.

### Status

Phase 1 is under construction with substantial completion anticipated fall 2025. Phase 2 will include pedestrian facilities across the Little Susitna River.

### Schedule

Future phases are dependent on funding.
