


CHERI LAKE DRIVE-KING ARTHUR DRIVE CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS



Project Scope

Upgrade approximately 2.25 miles of road between the Parks Highway and Three Bees Road to provide wider travel lanes, shoulders, improved drainage and install safety improvements.

Benefits

The project will provide an upgraded road corridor between the City of Houston and the Meadow Lakes area capable of carrying existing and future traffic as a high level of development continues in this area.

An upgrade from gravel surface to asphalt will reduce dust.

Adding shoulders and less steep embankment slopes will increase safety and provide additional clear zone for vehicles to recover when running off the road.

Wider and deeper ditches with upgraded culverts will improve drainage and provide for more snow storage.

Status

Design for the Cheri Lake Drive - King Arthur Drive corridor improvements is underway. Field investigations have begun, including surveying and a geotechnical investigation. Field investigations will continue through the fall of 2022.

This project will require design, right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation and construction.

Project Costs

Project costs are estimated at \$3,500,000.
